1. Application

2. Documents *(Please rename/label the filename)*

1. Application stage

We initially asks for partial documents during the application, as follows:

- a. Pupil's passport copy
- b. Pupil's Emirates ID copy front & back (if UAE resident)
- c. Previous final school report/most recent term report (for Year 1 and above). Nursery (FS1) report is optional.
- d. Medical report (IEP report, Speech, and language report), if applicable.
- e. Pupil's photo

2. Place offered

- a. Pupil's visa copy
- b. Mother's passport copy
- c. Mother's visa copy
- d. Mother's EID copy
- e. Father's passport copy
- f. Father's visa copy
- g. Father's EID copy
- h. Family book (for UAE Nationals only)
- i. Immunization record
- j. Birth Certificate
- k. **Transfer certificate (*Attestation is applicable for specific countries only)*
- l. **Previous final school report with signed and school stamped.*

3. Assessments/Appointment/Decision

For Nursery & Reception, we hold playdates onsite. If you are overseas at the time of applying, we would kindly ask you to send us a video clips of your child showcasing his/her skills and abilities and the Head of Lower Primary will review the child's application.

On occasions, your child may be asked for a second playdate or a classroom experience so the academic team can see your child in our learning environment. Amity will also request a character reference from current/previous school, if applicable.

For Year 1 & Year 2, the Head of Lower Primary will review the application along with the school report provided or video if required. Optionally, we will invite the child to come to school for observation and/or a phonics assessment. Amity will also request a character reference from current/previous school.

For Year 3 to Year 13 pupils, they will be invited to sit a CAT4 entry assessment and we will invigilate him/her assessment via MS Teams video or on campus. The Head of School will review the result along with the school report and other school/academic materials provided. Pupils will be invited for a classroom experience, for those overseas, a meeting on MS Teams will be arranged with the Head of School. Amity will also request a character reference from current/previous school.

For, Year 10 & above, there will be two parts of tests, the CAT 4 and if required, a meeting with the Head of School or a subject specialist.

4. Registration to the Department of Education & Knowledge (ADEK)

All private school in Abu Dhabi are being regulated by the ADEK, therefore all schools shall abide by the law & regulations.

All pupils must be registered to the ADEK eSIS system before starting to school, failure to register pupil unto eSIS, will lead to complications and potential fines.

Should there be a delay in providing the Emirates ID before the child's start date, please feel free to let us know in order to assist you.

We suggests you to prepare the transfer certificate before your relocation to the UAE.
