

## **UNIFORM POLICY**

#### **AMITY MISSION STATEMENT**

It is our mission to create an engaging and challenging learning environment where students are encouraged to excel intellectually, academically and socially. We nurture our students' natural desires to learn with a personalised educational programme, project-based learning and guided enquiry. These promote the development of independent thinking, critical analysis, emotional intelligence and essential communication skills. Amity International School aims to serve all its Students by preparing a diverse range of courses, programmes, resources and facilities that serve Students' individual talents and interests, and help them secure the best chance of success and happiness in both their professional and personal lives.

#### **RATIONALE**

Amity International School requires all students to wear a school uniform every school day unless it is a designated theme or home clothes day. The uniform must conform to the shades, styles, textures, and colours determined by the school and purchased from the designated school uniform suppliers.

#### **PURPOSE**

The aims and purpose of this policy are to:

- Reflect school community standards and expectations
- Contribute to the health and safety of students when engaged in school activities

## **RESPONSIBILITY**

## Staff will:

- Remind students of the uniform expectations
- Check that students are wearing the correct uniform; form/class teachers will reach out to parents as required.

### Parents will:

- Ensure their children have the correct school uniform
- Ensure school uniform is correctly and fully labelled
- Reinforce and support the school expectations with their children

## Students will:

- Keep their uniform clean and tidy, ensuring it is worn in a presentable way
- Wear the uniform in full (including not mixing PE and formal uniform) both to and from school and when representing the school
- Wear the PE uniform for PE and sports lessons and only on days when a student has PE or a sports CCA
- During warmer months, primary school students are required to wear hats for outdoor play
- During cooler months, students are only permitted to wear the Amity sweater at school

### Boys specifically will:

• Cut their hair in a conventional short style, above the collar and ears

### Girls specifically wear:

- One pair of small plain stud earrings, which must be removed independently during PE classes for safety reasons or covered with surgical tape. No other piercings are allowed, and all other jewellery must remain at home.
- Hair in a neat style and refrain from using non-natural colour dyes. Extravagant hairstyles are not permitted
- Hairbands, clips, and bobbles that match the uniform and are of a modest nature

#### **WEARABLE TECHNOLOGY**

The use of smartwatches and other technology-related accessories is prohibited during the school day. Earphones and headphones are only permitted when explicitly required for a specific lesson, such as a language listening activity.

#### **NAMING ITEMS**

All uniform items must be named to facilitate the return of lost property. Unclaimed lost property will be displayed termly before being disposed of.

#### **SANCTIONS**

- Students who fail to follow the uniform regulations will be subject to the sanctions outlined in the school's behaviour policy
- The school reserves the right to refuse entry to students who repeatedly disregard the uniform policy
- Final decisions on proper uniform compliance rest with the Head of School

#### **SCHOOL UNIFORM LIST**

Detailed uniform lists for Lower Primary, Upper Primary, Secondary, and Sixth Form, including approved footwear and PE attire, are published on the school's website and the appendices.

#### **SCHOOL BAGS**

Trolley bags are not allowed. Parents are requested to ensure that school bags fall within the recommended weight limits by year group as outlined in the ADEK Policy Limiting School Bag Weight (September 2024). See below for reference:
